

NVIT BlueprintSM Capital Appreciation Fund — Class I

Investment Strategy from investment's prospectus

The investment seeks growth of capital, but also seeks income consistent with a less aggressive level of risk as compared to other BlueprintSM Funds. The fund is a "fund of funds" that invests primarily in affiliated mutual funds representing a variety of asset classes. It aims to provide diversification across traditional asset classes—U.S. stocks, international stocks, and bonds—by investing primarily in mutual funds offered by Nationwide Variable Insurance Trust and affiliated or unaffiliated exchange-traded funds ("ETFs").

Past name: NVIT Cardinal Capital Appreciation I.

Category Description: Allocation—50% to 70% Equity

Funds in allocation categories seek to provide both income and capital appreciation by investing in multiple asset classes, including stocks, bonds, and cash. These portfolios are dominated by domestic holdings and have equity exposures between 50% and 70%.

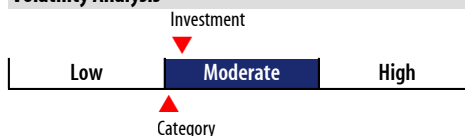

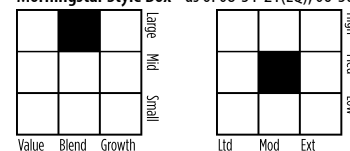
